

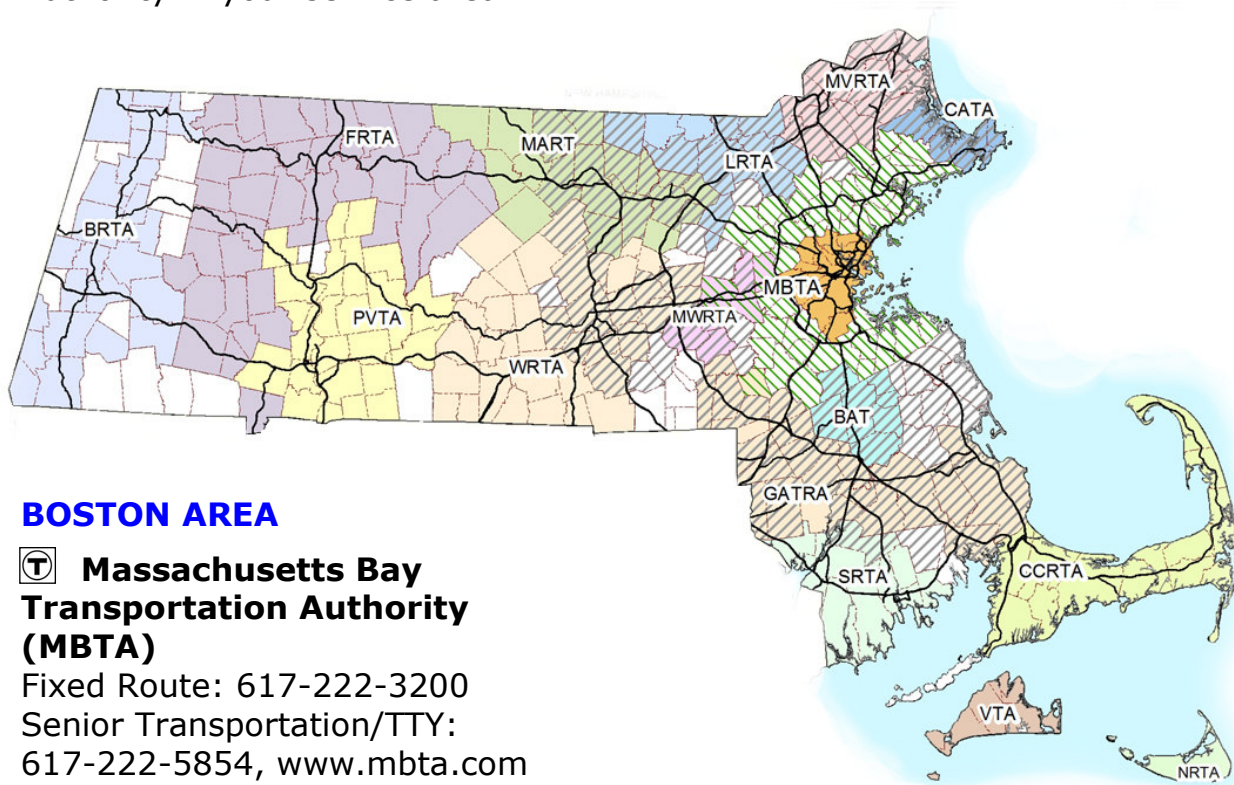

Many of us are finding that we're not as mobile as we used to be and driving our own car is not the best option.

Your public transportation agencies have the answer for you... The intent of this brochure is to provide you with contact information for the public transportation agency in your area. Getting a ride on public transportation buses and vans is only a phone call away. Your

public transportation agency is here to help you when you can't or no longer want to drive yourself.

By contacting the public transportation agency in your community they will assist you in how they can meet your transportation needs, provide information and even assist you on your first ride on a bus or van to help you transition comfortably.

Public transportation, both in the form of established scheduled routes and accessible vans, are readily available to Massachusetts seniors with or without disabilities. Public transportation vehicles provide wheelchair lifts and other special devices to assist those with limited mobility.

Although the costs may vary between agencies, it is very inexpensive to use public transportation. Most, if not all agencies, have special senior fares and pass discounts.
